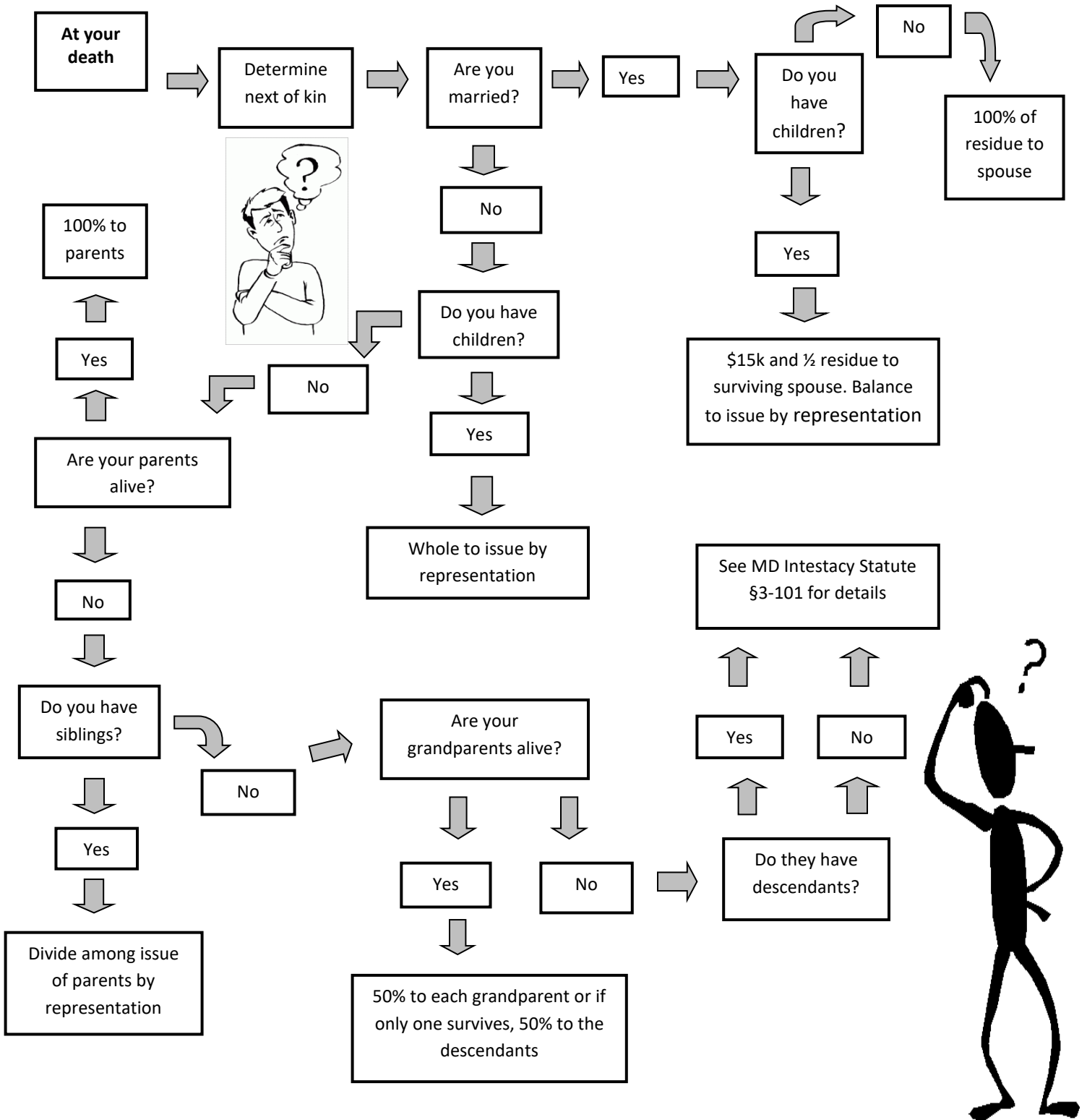


Death Without a Will in Maryland
